1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD 2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF 3 RYAN WHITE PROGRAM FUNDS TO SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS IN THE 4 ESTIMATED AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$20,206,459 FOR RYAN WHITE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE 5 NEW AGREEMENTS WITH SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS AND TAKE ALL 6 7 NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 8 AGREEMENTS: AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health
Resources and Services Administration ("HRSA") annually awards funds to Broward
County for the provision of Ryan White Part A core medical and support services, Minority
AIDS Initiative services, planning and evaluation services, and Ending the HIV Epidemic
("EHE") program services (collectively, the "Services");

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida ("Board"), approved the HRSA Ryan White Part A grant application for the award period commencing on March 1, 2025, and ending on February 29, 2028;

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2024, the Board approved the HRSA Ryan White EHE
grant application for the award period commencing on March 1, 2025, and ending on
February 28, 2030;

WHEREAS, the Board anticipates an award of HRSA Ryan White Part A and EHE
funds for Ryan White Fiscal Year 2025-2026 ("FY2026") and expects payment of funds
(in part) from HRSA for Services by March 1, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to renew for FY2026 existing agreements with specified service providers (previously approved by the Board in Resolution No. 2024-004, January 23, 2024, Item No. 15) to continue the provision of Services and to authorize the Broward County Administrator ("County Administrator") to execute new agreements with specified service providers for the provision of Services; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Services to be funded benefit the residents of
Broward County and serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF 33 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of
funds in the estimated aggregate amount of Twenty Million Two Hundred Six Thousand
Four Hundred Fifty-nine Dollars (\$20,206,459), as specified in Attachments A and B, for
FY2026.

38 Section 2. Upon receipt of the grant award from HRSA, the service providers'
39 agreements identified in Attachment A will be renewed for FY2026 in accordance with the
40 terms and conditions of the agreements.

Section 3. Upon receipt of the grant award from HRSA, the County
Administrator is hereby authorized to execute new agreements with certain service
providers identified in Attachments A and B for FY2026 in substantially the same form as
the applicable Board-approved standard form agreement. The County Administrator is

further authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to
implement the agreements. Nothing in this Resolution alters the requirement that
agreements be reviewed and approved for legal sufficiency by the County Attorney's
Office before execution. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form
agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

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Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

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Section 5. Effective Date.

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This Resolution is effective upon adoption.

1. Single source determination for the FDOH to provide Public Health Surveillance, Disease Intervention Specialist services in Broward County from March 1, 2025, through February 28, 2026, in the amount of \$312,000, with four one-year renewal periods, for a five-year potential amount of \$1,560,000.

2. "Estimated Subtotal Funded Services" increased by \$38,812 over amount shown in Exhibit 1 - Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Summary of Services approved by the Commission on October 8, 2024 (Item No. 8), for the HRSA EHE Ryan White grant application. This change reflects shifts in awarded Service Category amounts based on open, competitive Request for Proposals.

3. "Amount retained by Broward County for project expenses" decreased by \$38,812 below amount shown in Exhibit 1 - Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) Summary of Services approved by the Commission on October 8, 2024 (Item No. 8), for the HRSA EHE Ryan White grant. This change will not negatively impact Broward County's administrative budget for the EHE program.
