Requested Action

- A. <u>MOTION TO APPOINT</u> Daniel "Willie" Wilcoxen to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.
- B. <u>MOTION TO APPROVE</u> waiver of conflict under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes for Daniel "Willie" Wilcoxen who holds employment or contractual relationships with entities that receive funds from Broward County.

Why Action is Necessary

- B. A waiver of conflict arising under Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, requires two-thirds approval by the Board in accordance with Section 112.313(12), Florida Statutes.

What Action Accomplishes

- A. Appoints Daniel "Willie" Wilcoxen to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board.
- B. Waives the existence of any conflict arising under Section 112.313(7)(a), as authorized under applicable law.
