ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE REPEAL OF OBSOLETE OR OUTDATED PROVISIONS IN CHAPTER 1 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); REPEALING SECTION 1-6 RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS FOR CERTAIN BROWARD COUNTY EMPLOYEES, SECTION 1-8 RELATING TO PUBLIC INFORMATION ON THE ENERGY CRISIS, SECTION 1-12 RELATING TO ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO PUBLIC RECORDS, SECTION 1-20 RELATING TO THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS WITH SECOND PARTIES, SECTION 1-21 RELATING TO THE TIME LIMITATION ON BRINGING MATTERS BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND SECTION 1-46 RELATING TO INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSES IN FEDERAL PROJECT CONTRACTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 1-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Purchase of uniforms by county for certain employees," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 1-8 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Expenditures and budgeting for purpose of public information on energy crisis," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. Section 1-12 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Electronic access to public records," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Section 1-20 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Execution by commission of agreements with second parties," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 5. Section 1-21 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Time limitation on bringing matters before the board of county commissioners," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 6. Section 1-46 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, entitled "Indemnification clauses in federal project contracts, etc.," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 7. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 8. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word

“ordinance” may be changed to “section,” “article,” or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
