On April 20, 2015, the Director of Purchasing executed an Agreement between Broward County ("County") and Safety & Security Instruction ("SSI") for support and maintenance of SSI's Onsite Interactive Learning System (ILS) and eXpress Course, for an initial three-year term with two one-year extensions, in the maximum not-to-exceed amount of \$70,000.

On March 23, 2017, the Director of Purchasing approved the First Amendment to the Agreement, replacing the terms and conditions in their entirety while keeping the effective date and associated renewals, and increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$245,000, increasing the total Agreement amount from \$70,000 to \$315,000.

On February 27, 2018 (Item No. 66), the Board approved the Second Amendment to the Agreement to formulate emergency response training for Airport employees and to increase the delegated authority for Optional Services purchases, increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$200,000, increasing the total Agreement amount from \$315,000 to \$515,000.

On August 1, 2018, the Director of Purchasing approved the Third Amendment to the Agreement to provide training for an Airport Employee Emergency Training Program ("AEET Program") in multiple languages, increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$250,000, increasing the total Agreement amount from \$515,000 to \$765,000.

On April 7, 2020 (Item No. 3), the Board approved the Fourth Amendment to the Agreement to add three renewal terms to provide continued support and maintenance of the ILS, simple course builder, and to add and update security related provisions to the Agreement. The not-to-exceed amount was not changed.
