The Future Land Use Element of the City of Hallandale Beach's Comprehensive Plan is the effective land use plan for the City of Hallandale Beach. That plan designates the area covered by this plat for the uses permitted in the "Hallandale Beach Regional Activity Center" land use category. This plat is generally located on the southeast corner of Southeast 7 Street and Old Federal Highway (Southeast 2 Avenue).

Regarding the proposed residential use, this plat is subject to the executed "Interlocal Agreement for the Monitoring of Development Activity and Enforcement of Permitted Land Uses in Regional Activity Center," as recorded in Official Record Book 48444, Pages 1779-1785.

Further, it is noted that the Hallandale Beach Regional Activity Center permits 4,241 dwelling units. Said dwelling units were not subject to the Broward County Land Use Plan (BCLUP) Policy 2.16.2 as the associated amendment did not propose any additional residential units to the BCLUP.

The effective land use plan shows the following land uses surrounding the plat:

North: Regional Activity Center
South: Regional Activity Center
East: Regional Activity Center
West: Regional Activity Center

The contents of this memorandum are not a judgment as to whether this development proposal complies with the Broward County Trafficways Plan, local zoning, other land development regulations or the development review requirements of the Broward County Land Use Plan including its concurrency requirements.
