188	The following fee schedule is hereby adopted:						
189	a. Impound and Board Fees. Impound and board fees shall be paid by the owner						
190	of any dog or cat impounded. Released ear-notched feral or community cats that are part						
191	of any established colony shall have impound fees waived. Offenses are determined by the						
192	owner's name, not the animal's name. Impound fees are also applicable to dogs and cats						
193	redeemed or claimed from quarantine. The Animal Care Division may set up a payment						
194	plan for individuals who cannot pay the entire amount of their fees at the time the animal is						
195	released. The Director, taking into account: (i) owners who reclaim their dog or cat prior to						
196	it being impounded or within twenty-four (24) hours after the animal's arrival, or (ii) owners						
197	who meet federal low income guidelines, may decrease or waive the impound and board						
198	fees. Additionally, the Director may decrease or waive the impound and board fees under						
199	certain circumstances including, but not limited to, overcapacity of the animal shelter and						
200	special events, if doing so increases the likelihood of a positive outcome or release for a						
201	sheltered animal.
