SUBJECT: Modification to the Recommendations of Approval

Pines & 72nd (015-MP-22)

The Highway Construction and Engineering Division, Traffic Engineering, and the Transportation Department, Transit Division have reviewed the application for a modification to the right of way requirements approved by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners on April 16, 2024. Our review included the information contained in the application, the property survey, the site plan (or conceptual access plan), and any previously recorded plats.

The applicant submitted a traffic study analyzing the traffic impacts of the development proposed for this plat. Staff of the Public Works Department have determined that the traffic study demonstrates that the volume of traffic accessing the site from the proposed 40-foot opening on 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue will not adversely affect traffic conditions without the construction of a right turn lane. This determination provides the basis for the County Commission to waive the right turn lane construction requirements pursuant to the Broward County Land Development Code.

All recommendations remain as previously approved with the exception of item number 13 which is recommended for waiver approval.

As a result of our review, staff has determined that the comments and recommendations are required with respect to the safe and adequate access standards of the Broward County Land Development Code.
