## **Exhibit B – Examples of Impacts Unique to the Cities**

Any of the following qualify to the extent not reimbursed or otherwise funded by WMIF:

- 1. Monitoring, including environmental monitoring, for compliance with Settlement Agreement conditions.
- 2. Maintenance Activities: There are numerous maintenance activities that the Cities must conduct to keep roads, properties, and waterways safe and to mitigate environmental hazards. These activities include street sweeping, water tank trucks, rehabilitation of roadway markings, pressure washing of curbs and medians, and stormwater infrastructure cleaning. The foregoing are limited to maintenance activities that the Cities can reasonably demonstrate result from Landfill activities.
- 3. Right-of-Way Enhancements: Enhancements to public rights-of-way, medians, swales, buffers, and landscaping within two miles of the Landfill property. Beautification projects on public rights of way and property within two miles of the Landfill. The foregoing are limited to enhancements certified in writing by the City's Manager or public works director attesting that the primary justification for the enhancement is to mitigate impacts from the Landfill.
- 4. Traffic Enforcement related to commercial and waste vehicles that will be entering/exiting the Landfill for disposal or operational activities.
- 5. Public Safety services expenses (law enforcement and fire rescue services) incurred related to calls for service associated with the Landfill property.
