2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
3 OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
4 TO EXECUTE A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT AGREEMENT
5 WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION,
6 DISTRICT 4, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,693,430, TO PROVIDE
7 FISCAL YEAR 2022 BLOCK GRANT FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO
8 BROWARD COUNTY FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
9 OPERATING COSTS; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
10 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND
11 BUDGETARY ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
12 DATE.

13 WHEREAS, Section 341.052, Florida Statutes, created the public transit block
14 grant program administered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT);

15 WHEREAS, the public transit block grant program provides funding to public transit
16 providers to assist with operating costs for the provision of public transit services;

17 WHEREAS, Broward County is a recipient of public transit block grant funds;

18 WHEREAS, on December 8, 2020 (Item No. 12), the Broward County Board of
19 County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 2020-718 adopting the Broward County
20 Transit Development Plan 2021-2030 Annual Update;

21 WHEREAS, based upon the Broward County Transit Development Plan
22 2021-2030 Annual Update, FDOT approved Ten Million Six Hundred Ninety-three
23 Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$10,693,430) in Fiscal Year 2022 public transit
24 block grant funds for Broward County Transportation Department operating expenses;
and

WHEREAS, the Public Transportation Grant Agreement must be approved by the
transit agency's governing body, NOW, THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

4 Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida (the
5 "Board"), authorizes its Mayor to execute the Public Transportation Grant Agreement
6 (PTGA) with FDOT, District 4, attached as Exhibit 1, in the amount of Ten Million Six
7 Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$10,693,430), granted
8 under Financial Project No. 407186-3-84-01, to provide funding for public transportation
9 operating expenses for the project.

10 Section 2. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to take all necessary
11 administrative and budgetary actions to implement the PTGA.

12 Section 3. Effective Date.
13 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
