2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
3 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE REPEAL OF OBSOLETE OR OUTDATED
4 PROVISIONS IN CHAPTERS 1, 15, 20, 21, AND 23 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
5 CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); REPEALING SECTION 1-263 RELATING TO THE
6 PROHIBITION ON USE OF LOBBYING STATEMENTS, SECTIONS 15-1 AND 15-2
7 RELATING TO THE SALE OF UNPASTEURIZED MILK AND THE SALE OF MEAT,
8 SECTION 15-24 RELATING TO ADMINISTERING THE INFLUENZA VIRUS VACCINE,
9 ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 15 RELATING TO PRIVATE AMBULANCE COMPANIES,
10 ARTICLE VII OF CHAPTER 15 RELATING TO THE FIRE RESCUE DIVISION,
11 ARTICLE IX OF CHAPTER 15 RELATING TO THE NARCOTICS GUIDANCE COUNCIL,
12 ARTICLE XI OF CHAPTER 15 RELATING TO FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS, ARTICLE XI
13 OF CHAPTER 20 RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS, SECTION 21-1 RELATING
14 TO FOOD PURCHASES FROM THE DIVISION OF CORRECTIONS, SECTION 21-2
15 RELATING TO SOLICITATIONS OF CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS BY MINORS,
16 SECTION 21-5 RELATING TO THE PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES AT CERTAIN
17 INTERSECTIONS, AND SECTION 23-3 RELATING TO INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSES
18 IN AGREEMENTS WITH MUNICIPALITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,
19 INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
22 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

23 Section 1. Section 1-263 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
24 "Prohibition on use of lobbying statements," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

25 Section 2. Section 15-1 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled "Sale
26 of unpasteurized milk prohibited," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

27 Section 3. Section 15-2 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled "Sale
28 of meat; inspection and marking required; unlawful sales; enforcement," is hereby
29 repealed in its entirety.

30 Section 4. Section 15-24 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
31 "Administering influenza virus vaccine," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

32 Section 5. Article IV of Chapter 15 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
33 titled "AMBULANCE SERVICE," inclusive of Sections 15-59 and 15-60, is hereby
34 repealed in its entirety.

35 Section 6. Article VII of Chapter 15 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
36 titled "FIRE RESCUE DIVISION," inclusive of Sections 15-111 through 15-116, is hereby
37 repealed in its entirety.

38 Section 7. Article IX of Chapter 15 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
39 titled "NARCOTICS GUIDANCE COUNCIL," inclusive of Sections 15-138 and 15-139, is
40 hereby repealed in its entirety.

41 Section 8. Article XI of Chapter 15 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
42 titled "FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS," inclusive of Sections 15-151 through 15-163, is
43 hereby repealed in its entirety.

44 Section 9. Article XI of Chapter 20 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances,
45 titled "MERCHANDISING OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS," inclusive of Sections 20-229
46 through 20-233, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

47 Section 10. Section 21-1 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
48 "Sheriff and district school board authorized to purchase certain food from division of
49 corrections," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

50 Section 11. Section 21-2 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
51 "Solicitation by persons eighteen years of age or younger of charitable contributions from
52 occupants of vehicles in traffic prohibited," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

53 Section 12. Section 21-5 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
54 "Restriction of right-of-way vendors and solicitors at certain high traffic volume
55 intersections," is hereby repealed in its entirety.

56 Section 13. Section 23-3 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, titled
57 "Agreements with municipalities containing 'hold harmless' and indemnification clauses,"
58 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

59 Section 14. Severability.

60 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
61 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
62 Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be
63 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
64 determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual,
65 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

66 Section 15. Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

67 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
68 Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective
69 date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
70 "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or
71 phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.

72 Section 16. Effective Date.

73 This Ordinance is effective as of the date provided by law.
