

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BROWARD COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION
2 BOARD RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
3 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVE FUNDING, FROM THE BROWARD
4 COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND, TO ESTABLISH A HISTORIC
5 MARKER PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
6 DATE.

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8 WHEREAS, the Broward County Historic Preservation Board was established in
9 Section 5-535 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances (the "Code") to implement and give
10 effect to the County's historic preservation policy;

11 WHEREAS, the County's historic preservation policy is intended to:

12 (1) Effectuate and accomplish the protection, enhancement, and perpetuation of
13 buildings, structures, improvements, archaeological resources, landscape features, and
14 architectural resources of sites and districts that represent distinctive elements of the
15 County's cultural, social, economic, political, scientific, religious, prehistoric, and architectural
16 history;

17 (2) Safeguard the County's historical, cultural, archaeological, and architectural
18 heritage as embodied and reflected in such individual structures, sites, and districts and to
19 protect such structures, sites, and districts in order to maintain physical evidence of the
20 County's heritage;

21 (3) Foster civic pride in the accomplishments of the past;

22 (4) Protect and enhance the County's attraction to visitors and to support and
23 stimulate the economy thereby; and

24 (5) Promote the use of individual structures, sites, and districts for the education,
25 pleasure, and welfare of the residents of and visitors to Broward County;

26 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5-535(e)(2) of the Code, the Broward County Historic
27 Preservation Board is authorized to provide "historical markers . . . for individual historical
28 resources, districts, archaeological sites, archaeological zones, and paleontological zones";

29 WHEREAS, the Broward County Historic Preservation Board desires to identify
30 historic sites that have petitioned for recognition through the implementation of a Historic
31 Marker Program (the "Program");

32 WHEREAS, the Broward County Historic Preservation Board finds the Program to be
33 consistent with, beneficial to, and in support of the County's historic preservation policy;

34 WHEREAS, the Broward County Historic Preservation Trust Fund was established as
35 a trust fund created for the use and benefit of historic preservation within Broward County;

36 WHEREAS, expenditures from the County's Historic Preservation Trust Fund are
37 authorized by the Broward County Director of Finance and Administrative Services upon
38 receipt of a resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners; and

39 WHEREAS, the Broward County Historic Preservation Board has determined that the
40 Program is eligible for funding through the County's Historic Preservation Trust Fund, NOW,
41 THEREFORE,

43 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION
44 BOARD that:

45 Section 1. Broward County Historic Preservation Board recommends the Board of
46 County Commissioners adopt a resolution authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to
47 exceed fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), from the Broward County Historic Preservation
48 Trust Fund, to create a Historic Marker Program.

49 Section 2. Severability.


50 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
