4. Purpose/Description:
Accept U.S. EPA 105 grant award A-00402620-0. This is a two-year grant, from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2021, and requires a County match. The Agreement total funding is \$1,466,500, of which the County in-kind match is \$586,600. This grant involves multiple awards.
This action approves a new award and allocation in the amount of \$661,600, of which \$75,000 is awarded from U.S. EPA and \$586,600 is the County in-kind match. This funding supports the County's program to protect air quality so that it achieves established ambient air standards and protects human health. The program includes ambient air monitoring and various other activities to reduce or control air pollutants such as ozone, particulate matter, sulfur dioxide, carbon monoxide, nitrogen dioxide and lead. The Environmental Engineering and Permitting Division of the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department is a federally and state approved local air quality program, responsible for protecting and improving air quality in Broward County.
