As the Chair of the Children's Services Board (CSB) and pursuant to the Broward County Advisory Board Policies, I would like to recommend to the Broward County Board of County Commissioners approval of the CSB's funding reallocation recommendation for the Human Services Department, Community Partnerships Division, Children's Services Administration Section contract for Fiscal Year 2020. The CSB voted to support the recommendation at its meeting on February 21, 2020.

The funding reallocation will help address critical needs in our community for Behavioral Health treatment services for children and provide support services to their families. Because the action can be accomplished through the reallocation of existing dollars, it does not require additional County funds. Approving this action will ensure the most effective and efficient use of currently budgeted resources to serve the greatest number of children by providers that have a proven record of accomplishments.

The CSB strongly supports this recommendation and hope it will meet with the Commission's approval.
