Based upon three independent studies for Aviation, General Fund agencies and Water and Wastewater Services GIS needs assessments (Broward County Aviation Department GIS Strategic Plan dated September 2011, Enterprise GIS System Architecture Design August 2013, and Esri Deployment for Broward Water and Wastewater letter dated June 2014), staff has determined the ESRI Enterprise License Agreement (ELA) price to be fair and reasonable. ESRI's labor rates per hour for Professional Services range from \$207 to \$497. These rates are 3% below ESRI's Local Government Rates and 20% below ESRI's Commercial Pricing. They also represent a 2% CPI cap over the life of the contract. During negotiations the pricing was reduced another 1% and the CPI cap was reduced from 3.5% to 2%. GSA is under Federal Government Pricing which has volume discounts applied.
