

Notice of Public Hearing and Intent to Consider to
Vacate and Abandon
Two 10-Foot Utility Easements
(2020-V-05)

Notice is hereby given by the Board of County Commissioners, Broward County, Florida, that said Board will hold a Public Hearing at 10:00 A.M., Tuesday December 1, 2020 in the Broward County Governmental Center, Room 422, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to vacate, abandon, discontinue, and close two 10-foot utility easements on the perimeter of Parcel A of the Alexander Hamilton National Bank Plat No. 1, as recorded in Plat Book 107, Page 36 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, generally located on the east side of South State Road 7, between Southwest 13 Street and West McNab Road in the City of North Lauderdale. The full legal description is available for inspection at the Broward County Governmental Center, Planning and Development Management Division, 1 North University Drive, Room 102A, Plantation, Florida.

Interested parties may appear at the December 1, 2020, meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed release of easements. Public participation at the meeting shall be limited to telephonic participation only, pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order Number 20-69.
