

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 PERTAINING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT;
5 ADOPTING THE 2020 BROWARD COUNTY
6 COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN;
7 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
8 EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 WHEREAS, Chapter 27P-6 of the Florida Administrative Code, entitled "Review of
10 Local Emergency Management Plans," sets forth the requirements, format, and standards
11 for the development and maintenance of a County Comprehensive Emergency
12 Management Plan ("CEMP");

13 WHEREAS, Rule 27P-6.0023 of the Florida Administrative Code requires each
14 county to develop a CEMP, which is subject to review every four (4) years;

15 WHEREAS, the Florida Division of Emergency Management ("FDEM") has
16 completed its review of the proposed 2020 Broward County CEMP and determined that
17 it complies with the applicable requirements and criteria;

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 27P-6.006(11) of the Florida Administrative Code,
19 within ninety (90) days after the FDEM determines that a proposed CEMP complies with
20 the applicable requirements and criteria, the approved plan must be adopted by resolution
21 of the governing body; and

22 WHEREAS, upon adoption of the approved plan by the governing body, a copy of
23 the adopted resolution and an electronic copy of the approved plan must be provided to
24 the FDEM, NOW, THEREFORE,
