

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (“EMS”) GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY FOUR THOUSAND AND TEN DOLLARS (\$94,010), TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING AND EXPANDING PREHOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN BROWARD COUNTY; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE APPLICATION; PROVIDING CERTIFICATION RELATING TO THE USE OF EMS COUNTY GRANT FUNDS AND APPROVING BROWARD COUNTY’S EMS GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING DISTRIBUTION; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENTS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) desires to submit to the State of Florida, Department of Health (“DOH”), Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Broward County’s FY 2021 Emergency Medical Services (“EMS”) Grant Application (“Application”) for EMS County Grant Funds in the amount of Ninety Four Thousand Ten Dollars (\$94,010); and

WHEREAS, the Board certifies that the EMS County grant funds will be used to improve and expand prehospital EMS in Broward County, and will not be used to supplant existing County budget allocations for EMS;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve the EMS County Grant Program funding distribution, subject to approval of the Application by the DOH, NOW, THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

4 Section 1. The Board authorizes the County Administrator to execute and
5 submit the Application to DOH, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment A, for
6 EMS County grant funds in the amount of Ninety Four Thousand Ten Dollars (\$94,010).

7 Section 2. The County certifies that the EMS County grant funds will improve
8 and expand the County's prehospital emergency medical system and will not be used to
9 supplant existing County budget allocations for EMS.

10 Section 3. The County approves the DOH EMS Grant Program's Request for
11 Grant Fund Distribution attached hereto as Attachment B.

12 Section 4. Upon approval of the Application by the DOH, the County
13 Administrator is authorized to execute agreements in a form approved as to legal
14 sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney, which shall include the County's standard
15 form agreement provisions and incorporate insurance provisions approved by the
16 County's Risk Management Division, for the projects described in Attachment C hereto.
17 The County Administrator is authorized to execute amendments to the agreements, in
18 forms approved as to legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney, revising
19 project leaders, extending the term, or increasing the funding amount by utilizing
20 unexpended EMS County grant funds allocated for FY 2021 projects.

21 Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary
22 administrative and budgetary actions for implementation of same, and no County match
23 is required.

1 Section 6. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
3 portion shall be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of
4 this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot
5 be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
6 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
7 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

8 Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

9 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
