2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY  
4 TRANSMITTING A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE  
5 WATER MANAGEMENT ELEMENT OF THE BROWARD  
6 COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO DESIGNATED  
7 STATE AGENCIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
8 DATE.

9 WHEREAS, Broward County adopted the Broward County Comprehensive Plan  
10 on April 25, 2017 (the Plan);

11 WHEREAS, the Department of Economic Opportunity has found the Plan in  
12 compliance with the Community Planning Act;

13 WHEREAS, Broward County now wishes to propose an amendment to the Water  
14 Management Element of the Plan;

15 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department,  
16 as the local planning agency for the Broward County Comprehensive Plan, held its  
17 hearing on the proposed amendment to the Water Management Element on  
18 December 14, 2020, with due public notice; and

19 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held its transmittal public  
20 hearing on February 23, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., having complied with the notice  
21 requirements specified in Subsection 163.3184, Florida Statutes, NOW, THEREFORE,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
23 BROWARD COUNTY:

24 Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby transmits to the  
Department of Economic Opportunity, South Florida Regional Planning Council, South  
Florida Water Management District, Department of Environmental Protection,  
Department of State, Department of Transportation, Fish and Wildlife Conservation

1 Commission, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and Department of  
2 Education, as applicable, for review and comment pursuant to Section 163.3184,  
3 Florida Statutes, which is an amendment to the Water Management Element.

4 Section 2. The proposed amendment 20-T4 to the Broward County  
5 Comprehensive Plan is attached as Attachment "A" to this Resolution.

6 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
