RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO MEETINGS; AMENDING SECTION 18.3 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2020, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") adopted a revised Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan ("CEMP"), which included changes to the County's emergency procedures;

WHEREAS, certain changes to the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code") and the Broward County Administrative Code are necessary to reflect the updates in the revised CEMP;

WHEREAS, the Board is considering an Ordinance to amend the Code to require the County Administrator to seek direction or guidance from the Board at a meeting or workshop prior to taking certain action; and

WHEREAS, if the proposed Ordinance is enacted, an amendment to the Broward County Administrative Code is also necessary to effectuate the changes and allow the County Administrator to call meetings and workshops of the Board under limited circumstances, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. Section 18.3 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **18.3. Meetings.**

4 . . .

5 b. *Special Meetings.* Special meetings of the County Commission may be  
6 held on the call of the Mayor or of five (5) or more members ~~upon~~. During declared states  
7 of emergency, and only when required to comply with the requirements of Section 8-53,  
8 Broward County Code of Ordinances, special meetings of the County Commission may  
9 be held on the call of the County Administrator. Any call for a special meeting shall  
10 provide no less than twelve (12) hours' effective notice to each member.

12 Section 2. Severability.

13 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to  
14 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity  
15 of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole  
16 or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or  
17 circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any  
18 other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

19 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

20 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this  
21 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code  
22 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be  
23 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
