

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, WAIVING SECTION 18.43(C) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING A COUNTY-OWNED ROAD AFTER A LIVING PERSON, CONGRESSMAN ALCEE L. HASTINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code ("Administrative Code") sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") for naming property owned by Broward County ("County");

WHEREAS, Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code provides that property owned by the County, including County roads, should not be named after living persons;

WHEREAS, Congressman Alcee L. Hastings ("Congressman Hastings") is a living person who has made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil rights leader; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the portion of NW 6th Court from NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue located in the Broward Municipal Services District ("County Road") as "Alcee Hastings Street" in honor of Congressman Hastings, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby waives the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the County Road as “Alcee Hastings Street” in honor of Congressman Hastings.

Section 2. Severability.

If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
