

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF  
5 U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES  
6 FUNDS IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$1,058,536 TO  
7 SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR RYAN WHITE  
8 FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY  
9 ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY  
10 ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO  
11 IMPLEMENT THE AGREEMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR  
12 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services,  
14 Health Resources and Services Administration (“HRSA”) has previously awarded funds  
15 to Broward County under the *Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America* (“EHE,”  
16 formerly ETE) — *Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program* to reduce new HIV infections and  
17 expand the provision of services in Broward County, Florida, to (i) individuals newly  
18 diagnosed with HIV, (ii) individuals living with HIV who are not engaged in care, and  
19 (iii) individuals with detectable amounts of HIV in their blood;

20 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida  
21 (“Board”), anticipates an award of EHE funds for Ryan White fiscal year 2021-2022  
22 (“FY22”) and expects payment of the funds (in part) from HRSA by March 1, 2021;

23 WHEREAS, the Board previously approved funding to certain service providers  
24 (Resolution No. 2020-362, August 25, 2020, Item No. 2) and desires to provide  
FY22 renewal funding to those service providers to continue the provision of  
EHE program services; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the services to be funded benefit the residents of  
Broward County and serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

4 Section 1. Authorized Appropriation and Disbursement.

5 The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of funds in the  
6 estimated amount of One Million Fifty-eight Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-six Dollars  
7 (\$1,058,536) to service providers for FY22, as specified in Attachment A.

8 Section 2. Administrative Action by the County Administrator.

9 The agreements with the service providers identified in Attachment A will be  
10 renewed for FY22 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreements.  
11 Upon receipt of the full grant award, the Broward County Administrator is hereby  
12 authorized to take all necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the  
13 agreements. Nothing in this Resolution alters the requirement that agreements be  
14 reviewed for legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney before execution. Any  
15 material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form agreement must be  
16 presented to the Board for approval.

17 Section 3. Severability.

18 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid  
19 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this  
20 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be  
21 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
22 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,  
23 group, entity, property, or circumstance.
