1 RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 WAIVING SECTION 18.43(D) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY  
5 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING A  
6 COUNTY-OWNED ROAD AFTER CONGRESSMAN ALCEE  
7 L. HASTINGS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND  
8 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code  
11 (“Administrative Code”) sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners  
12 (“Board”) for naming property owned by Broward County (“County”);

13 WHEREAS, Section 18.43(d) of the Administrative Code provides that property  
14 owned by the County, including County roads, may be named after persons who have  
15 passed away following a minimum 90-day waiting period;

16 WHEREAS, Congressman Alcee L. Hastings (“Congressman Hastings”) is a  
17 person who made numerous significant contributions to the County, including as a civil  
18 rights leader;

19 WHEREAS, Congressman Hastings sadly passed away on April 6, 2021, after a  
20 life dedicated to public service; and

21 WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(d) of the  
22 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the portion of NW 8th Street from  
23 NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st Avenue located in the Broward Municipal Services District  
24 (“County Road”) in honor of Congressman Hastings on June 1, 2021, NOW,  
THEREFORE

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
2 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

3 Section 1. The Board hereby waives the provisions of Section 18.43(d) of the  
4 Administrative Code in order to consider renaming the County Road in honor of  
5 Congressman Hastings.

6 Section 2. Severability.

7 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid  
8 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this  
9 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be  
10 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
11 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,  
12 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

13 Section 3. Effective Date.

14 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
