RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING PARTICIPATION OF MINORITY-OWNED BUSINESSES IN BROWARD COUNTY'S BUSINESS COMMUNITY AND FAIR AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE FOR BROWARD COUNTY CONTRACTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County is one of the most diverse regions in the country, with a wide variety of minority groups that recognize and value diversity in race, ethnicity, religion, gender identity, and sexual orientation;

WHEREAS, Broward County has been at the forefront of protecting the rights of minority communities, including by mandating nondiscrimination as a standard contracting term for County contracts and by enforcing equal employment opportunity policies regarding hiring;

WHEREAS, Broward County is committed to providing all businesses fair and equal opportunities to compete for County contracts when eligible;

WHEREAS, Broward County applauds organizations such as the National LGBT Chamber of Commerce, the National Association of Black Women in Construction, and the many other associations similarly focused on providing valuable training, networking, and strategic partnerships to support business opportunities for minority-owned businesses;

WHEREAS, the National LGBT Chamber of Commerce is a business voice for the lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender ("LGBT") community, focused on expanding

1 economic opportunities and promoting advancement for LGBT individuals, and serves as
2 a certifying body for LGBT-owned businesses;

3 WHEREAS, the National Association of Black Women in Construction is organized
4 to increase the national awareness of Black women in the construction industry, advocate
5 for Black women-owned construction businesses for contract opportunities, and help train
6 the next generation of Black women and minorities in the construction industry;

7 WHEREAS, Broward County welcomes and encourages all business owners,
8 including minority-owned business owners, to participate in County-sponsored training
9 programs and services offered by the Office of Economic and Small Business
10 Development to ensure such business owners are prepared and knowledgeable on how
11 to do business with Broward County and are aware of current procurement opportunities,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

17 Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners ("Board")
18 reaffirms its support for the full participation of minority-owned businesses in Broward
19 County's business community.

20 Section 2. The Board supports fair and equal consideration and competition for
21 all businesses, including minority-owned businesses, for Broward County contracts.

22 Section 3. The Board welcomes and encourages all business owners, including
23 minority business owners, to participate in County-sponsored training programs through
24 the Broward County Office of Economic and Small Business Development to learn about

County procurement opportunities and procedures. Broward County is committed to providing programming to ensure minority-owned businesses have access to information that will support their business growth and ability to do business in Broward County.

Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
