ORDINANCE 2018-23 SECTION 1-81.9

Program Graduation. A CBE or SBE that exceeds the CBE or SBE gross revenue or personal net worth eligibility requirements of this Act, as applicable, will be designated by the Program Director as a graduate of the Program. Program graduates may complete their work under all current County projects under their previous CBE or SBE status provided that the Bid submission date of those projects occurred prior to the CBE's or SBE's date of Program graduation. CBEs or SBEs decertified for cause shall not be considered Program graduates under this Act.
