3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 WAIVING SECTION 18.43(C) OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
5 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO CONSIDER NAMING A
6 COURTROOM IN THE BROWARD COUNTY
7 COURTHOUSE AFTER A LIVING PERSON, CHIEF JUDGE
8 JACK B. TUTER, JR.; AND PROVIDING FOR
9 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code
12 (“Administrative Code”) sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners
13 (“Board”) for naming property owned by Broward County (“County”);

14 WHEREAS, Section 18.43(c) of the Administrative Code provides that property,
15 buildings, structures, and facilities owned by the County should not be named after living
16 persons;

17 WHEREAS, Chief Judge Jack B. Tuter, Jr. (“Judge Tuter”), has made numerous
18 significant contributions to the County, including serving as the Chief Judge of the
19 Seventeenth Judicial Circuit since 2017; and

20 WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive the provisions of Section 18.43(c) of the
21 Administrative Code in order to consider naming the complex trial and ceremonial
22 courtroom on the seventeenth floor of the County-owned Broward County Judicial
23 Complex, located at 201 SE Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 (“County
24 Courtroom”), in honor of Judge Tuter, NOW, THEREFORE,
