5	20-176.144 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES ("CODE"); REPEALING
6	SECTION 8½-16(DD) OF THE CODE RELATING TO FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
7	LOCKSMITH ACT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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11	WHEREAS, on June 29, 2021, Governor Ron DeSantis signed Chapter 2021-214,
12	Laws of Florida, which, among other things, provides that the licensing of occupations is
13	generally preempted to the state and supersedes local government licensing
14	requirements for occupations;
15	WHEREAS, Chapter 2021-214, Laws of Florida, created a new Section 163.211,
16	Florida Statutes, which became effective July 1, 2021, and precludes local licensing
17	requirements enacted after January 1, 2021, that are not expressly permitted under
18	Section 163.211 or authorized by general law;
19	WHEREAS, the Broward County Locksmith Act, Section 20-176.130, et seq., of
20	the Broward County Code of Ordinances ("Code"), was enacted on February 9, 2021,
21	and is preempted under Section 163.211, Florida Statutes; and
22	WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it prudent to repeal the
23	Broward County Locksmith Act,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Sections 20-276.130 through 20-176.44 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 8½-16(dd) of the Broward County Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed in its entirety.

## Section 3. Severability.

If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance. If any court determines that this Ordinance, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Ordinance to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

## Section 4. <u>Inclusion in the Broward County Code of Ordinances</u>.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance become part of the Broward County Code of Ordinances as of the effective date. The sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary in order to accomplish such intention.
