RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE BROWARD COUNTY BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY ACT OF 2012; AMENDING SECTIONS 19.40 AND 19.40.1 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners finds that amending Sections 19.40 and 19.40.1 of the Broward County Administrative Code, pertaining to the administrative procedures for implementing the Broward County Business Opportunity Act of 2012, is appropriate at this time, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 19.40 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

19.40. Administrative Procedures for Implementing the Broward County Business Opportunity Act ~~of 2012~~.

Section 2. Section 19.40.1 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

19.40.1. General Provisions, Purposes, Construction, and Application.

1 (b) The Program Director shall be responsible for:

2 (1) Administration and enforcement of the Business Opportunity Act ~~of 2012~~
3 (the "Act");

5 (8) Acting as the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Liaison Officer
6 ("DBELO") for Broward County, consistent with Title 49 CFR Part 26,
7 responsible for certification and evaluation of compliance with the Federal
8 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise ("DBE") and Airport Concessions
9 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise ("ACDBE") programs. The Assistant
10 Director of OESBD shall be the Assistant DBELO;

13 Section 3. Severability.

14 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
15 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity
16 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
17 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
18 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
19 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
20 property, or circumstance.
