A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE APPLICATION OF RAIDER ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES OF FLORIDA, INC., FOR THE GRANTING OF A RENEWAL OF A NONEXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR A FIVE-YEAR TERM TO PROVIDE VESSEL OILY WASTE REMOVAL SERVICES AT PORT EVERGLADES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida, that:

Section 1. The County Administrator in and for Broward County, Florida, and ex officio Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County is authorized and directed to publish notice of intent of the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County to consider at public hearing on Tuesday, September 21, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., the application of Raider Environmental Services of Florida, Inc., for the granting of a renewal of a nonexclusive franchise for a five-year term to provide vessel oily waste removal services at Port Everglades.

Section 2. Such notice shall be published twice (September 10, 2021, and September 17, 2021), with the first publication not less than ten days before the public hearing and the second publication seven days after the first publication, pursuant to the applicable provisions of Chapter 94-429, Laws of Florida.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
