11	WHEREAS, Section 18.43 of the Broward County Administrative Code
12	("Administrative Code") sets out the policy of the Board of County Commissioners
13	("Board") for naming property owned by Broward County ("County");
14	WHEREAS, that portion of NW 11th Street from NW 27th Avenue to NW 31st
15	Avenue is a County-owned road located in the Broward Municipal Services District
16	("County Road");
17	WHEREAS, the adjoining portion of NW 11th Street between NW 23rd Avenue
18	and NW 26th Avenue, which is in the City of Fort Lauderdale city limits, has the primary
19	name of "Panther Lane;"
20	WHEREAS, the designation of the County Road as "Panther Lane" would serve to
21	extend the portion of the right-of-way designated as "Panther Lane" to incorporate the
22	County Road;
23	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 336.05, Florida Statutes, the Board is authorized
24	to name and rename County-owned streets and roads;

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2021 (Agenda Item No. 63), the Board (1) provided notice on the record that the Board would consider the proposed designation of the County Road as required by Section 18.43(h) of the Administrative Code; and (2) directed the County Administrator to solicit the input of at least three local municipalities, homeowners' associations, or community groups of the Board's proposed renaming of the County Road, which correspondence is attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to designate County Road as "Panther Lane," NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board hereby renames the County Road as "Panther Lane." In accordance with Section 18.43(g) of the Administrative Code, the current name of the County Road shall be retained as a secondary designation.

Section 2. The Board directs the County Administrator to take all budgetary and other actions necessary to effectuate the renaming of the County Road as "Panther Lane."

Section 3. The Board further directs the County Administrator, as Clerk of the Board, to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division, the Broward County Sheriff's Office, and the Broward County Sheriff's Office Department of Fire Rescue.
