#### **Requested Action**

**MOTION TO ADOPT** Resolution accepting a groundwater monitoring well easement located at 1650 NE 50th Court in Pompano Beach from the City of Pompano Beach at no cost to the County; authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute same and authorize recordation of same. **(Commission District 4)**

Board of County Commissioners' approval is required to accept an interest in real property pursuant to Broward County Administrative Code, Section 6.23.

Provides Broward County with a groundwater monitoring well easement for the installation and maintenance of a saltwater facility.

#### **Summary Explanation/Background**

The Water Management Division requested an easement for the installation of a groundwater monitoring well facility located at 1650 NE 50th Court in Pompano Beach. On January 25, 2022, the City of Pompano Beach approved Resolution No. 2022-62 granting the County a nonexclusive and perpetual easement to install, maintain, and repair a gaging station, groundwater monitoring well, and other installations required to monitor groundwater salinity.
