On October 7, 2019, Resolve Marine Group, Inc., filed a bid protest with the Broward County Purchasing Division as a result of the Purchasing Division's recommendation for award of Bid No. PNC 2117911C1, Segment II Nearshore Hardbottom Mitigation. In its response to the bid protest, the Purchasing Division advised of its decision to reject all bids to allow for revision of the bid specifications and issuance of a new, revised solicitation.
