September 10, 2020 - The County Commission continued this item to September 22, 2020.

April 21, 2020 - The County Commission approved transmittal of proposed amendment PCT 20-2 to State review agencies; and August 25, 2020 - Set adoption Public Hearing for September 10, 2020.

Summary Explanation/Background

The Planning Council, as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) responsible for the Broward County Land Use Plan, considered the following proposed text amendment, PCT 20-2, at its February 27, 2020, public hearing and recommended approval, including not requiring a second Planning Council public hearing (Vote of the Planning Council; Unanimous: 18-0; Blattner, Breslau, Brunson, Castillo, DiGiorgio, Fernandez, Gomez, Good, Graham, Hardin, Maxey, Parness, Railey, Rich, Rosenof, Ryan, Williams and Stermer):

AMENDMENT PCT 20-2

Amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan text regarding the existing Pompano Beach Downtown Activity Center, reducing development thresholds regarding commercial land uses and increasing hotel rooms and residential dwelling units.

Approximately 272.8 acres; generally bound on the north by Northwest 6 Street/Northwest 6 Court, on the south by Atlantic Boulevard/Southwest 2 Street, on the east by Northeast 5 Avenue, and on the west by Northwest 10 Avenue, located in the City of Pompano Beach.
