MOTION TO ADOPT budget Resolution No. 2020-505 within the General Fund transferring \$523,058 from the Broward Sheriff's Office Department of Detention reserve to the Department of Detention operating budget to pay invoices for inmate inpatient care costs incurred in Fiscal Years 2018, 2019, and 2020.

Transferring funds from reserves requires approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

Transfers \$523,058 from the BSO Department of Detention reserve to the Department of Detention operating budget to pay invoices for inmate inpatient care costs incurred in Fiscal Years 2018, 2019, and 2020.

Previous Action Taken

As part of the Fiscal Year 2020 1st supplemental budget, the Board appropriated \$3,000,000 in the BSO Department of Detention reserve for inmate inpatient care costs. The Board subsequently adopted budget resolutions on March 10, May 19, and August 25, 2020, which transferred a total of \$2,387,935 from the BSO Department of Detention reserve to the Department of Detention operating

budget to pay invoices for inmate inpatient care costs.
