Staff is requesting approval of a Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) that will provide \$182,088 in capital funding for park and ride leases, enhancements (signage, shelter, stops, etc.), and other costs associated with park and ride lots for I-95 Express Bus Service.
