Why Action is Necessary

It is necessary to schedule a public hearing of the Broward County Board of County Commissioners to be held subsequent to receipt of a recommendation from the Broward County Planning Council prior to adoption of an amendment to the Broward County Comprehensive Plan.

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What Action Accomplishes

The Resolution directs the County Administrator to set a public hearing for June 1, 2021, to consider adoption of proposed map amendment PC 21-3, which is an amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan, pursuant to Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes, as amended.

March 9, 2021 - The County Commission approved transmittal of proposed Broward County Land Use Plan amendment PC 21-3 to designated State review agencies.

Summary Explanation/Background

The Planning Council, as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) responsible for the Broward County Land Use Plan, considered the following proposed map amendment, PC 21-3, at its January 28, 2021 public hearing and recommended approval of an Irregular (35.3) Residential designation (rather than High (50) Residential), including not requiring a second Planning Council public hearing, and recognizing the applicant's voluntary commitment to restrict development to a maximum of 501 dwelling units (Vote of the Planning Council; 14-2; Yes: Breslau, Brunson, Castillo, Fernandez, Gomez, Graham, Hardin, Maxey, Railey, Rich, Rosenof, Ryan, Williams and DiGiorgio. No: Blackwelder and Grosso.):

AMENDMENT PC 21-3

Amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan - City of Lauderhill

From Commerce to High (50) Residential

Approximately 14.2 acres; generally located on the west side of University Drive, between Commercial Boulevard and Inverrary Boulevard/Northwest 50 Street. (Planning Council recommended Irregular (35.3) at its January 28, 2021 public hearing.)
