THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION.

The Planning and Development Management Division has received a request to vacate a five-foot utility easement lying within Lot 1, a three-foot utility easement lying within Lots 2 and 3, and a three-foot utility easement lying within Lot 15, all lying within Block 1 of Sunnyside Estates, as recorded in Plat Book 19, Page 35 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, and located at the southwest corner of Washington Street and South Dixie Highway in the City of Hollywood. Vacating these easements will provide clear and unencumbered title to the property owner.

The City of Hollywood adopted Resolution No. R-2021-V-015 on January 20, 2020, granting approval of the abandonment and vacation of the subject easements.
