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On February 8, 2022 (Agenda Item No. 19), the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County approved the transfer of a parcel of real property identified by folio 4943 0700 0400 and located in the Town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). After recording the deed, it was discovered that the deed contained a scrivener's error in the property's legal description. The Corrective Quit Claim Deed corrects the legal description of the property.
