("FPL") a perpetual, non-exclusive underground utility easement to direct power from Grande Avenue to feed a duct bank that will provide permanent power to the East Expansion of the Convention Center located at 1950 Eisenhower Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale and serve other existing facilities that are currently being powered by an FPL vault, which vault is to be demolished.
