MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution No. 2020-074 directing the County Administrator to publish Notice of Public Hearing to be held on Tuesday, March 31, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 422 of the Governmental Center, 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida to vacate a a portion of a 25-foot right-of-way as recorded in Deed Book 699, Page 233 of the Public Records of Broward County, located 400 Southwest 27 Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale; Petitioners: Clarkson-Bergman Family Partnership, Ltd.; Agent: Nectaria Chakas, Esq., Lochrie & Chakas, P.A.; Application for Vacation and Abandonment: 2018-V-24. **(Commission District 9)**

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION.

The Planning and Development Management Division has received a request to vacate a 25-foot right-of-way as recorded in Deed Book 699, Page 233, located at 400 Southwest 27 Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Vacating this right-of-way will provide clear and unencumbered title to the property owner.

City approval was not required for this request due to the County being the recipient of the deeded right-of-way and public interest was deemed unaffected. Review of this application by the applicable

reviewing agencies indicates that there is no objection to the abandonment and vacation of the subject right-of-way.
