### Requested Action

<u>MOTION TO ADOPT</u> Resolution No. 2020-696 to vacate a portion of a 50-foot right-of-way, known as Harding Street, lying within Hollywood Acres, as recorded in Plat Book 25, Page 1 of the Public Records of Broward County and is located at 1841 North State Road 7 in the City of Hollywood; Petitioners: Triangle Auto Center, Inc.; Agent: Jane Storms, Pulice Land Surveyors, Inc.; Application for Vacation and Abandonment: 2018-V-25. **(Commission District 6)** 

### Why Action is Necessary

Board approval is required to vacate plats, easements and rights-of-way pursuant to Chapter 5, Article IX of the Broward County Code of Ordinances.

#### What Action Accomplishes

Provides the property owner with clear unencumbered title to the lands in the areas affected by this vacation.

### Summary Explanation/Background

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION.

The Planning and Development Management Division has received a request to vacate a portion of a 50-foot right-of-way, known as Harding Street, lying within Hollywood Acres, as recorded in Plat Book 25, Page 1 of the Public Records of Broward County and is located at 1841 North State Road 7 in the City of Hollywood. Vacating this right-of-way will provide clear and unencumbered title to the property owners.

The City of Hollywood adopted Ordinance No. O-2018-12 on June 16, 2018 granting approval of the abandonment and vacation of the 50-foot right-of-way. Review of this application by the applicable

reviewing agencies indicates that there is no objection to the abandonment and vacation of the subject right-of-way.
