Consistent with these requirements, the County Administrator presents the nomination of Mr. Trevor Fisher for appointment to the position of Acting Director of Public Works Department with the recommendation that appointment be approved as presented, to be effective immediately upon approval.

Mr. Trevor Fisher has a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering and earned his Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.) in Global Management. Mr. Trevor Fisher is a Florida Registered Professional Engineer and has over 35 years of construction and project management experience in numerous public works projects.
