At the direction of the Board, certain amendments to the Business Opportunity Act of 2012 (the "Act") have been prepared by the Office of the County Attorney and are being considered by the Board under separate agenda items. The proposed Resolution, if adopted, would update references to the Act in the Broward County Administrative Code to align with this name change.
