MOTION TO ADOPT Resolution directing the County Administrator to publish Notice of Public Hearing to be held on August 22, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 422 of Governmental Center East, to release a portion of a right-of-way easement granted by the Deed recorded in Official Records Book 4673, Page 953 and abandon that certain right-of-way recorded in Miscellaneous Plat Book 6, Page 23 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, generally on the west side of Davie Road between Service Road and Southwest 37th Street in the Town of Davie; Petitioners: District Board of Trustees Broward Jr. College c/o Jayson Iroff Facilities Management; Agent: Cynthia Pasch, Greenspoon Marder, LLP; Application for Vacation and Abandonment: 2023-V-03. **(Commission District 5)**

Summary Explanation/Background

THE RESILIENT ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT AND THE URBAN PLANNING DIVISION RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE ABOVE MOTION.

The Urban Planning Division has received a request to release a portion of a right-of-way easement granted by the deed recorded in Official Records Book 4673, Page 953 and abandon that certain right-of-way recorded in Miscellaneous Plat Book 6, Page 23 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, generally on the west side of Davie Road between Service Road and Southwest 37th Street in the Town of Davie. Vacating this easement will provide clear and unencumbered title to the property owner.

Review of this application by the applicable reviewing agencies indicates that there is no objection to the release of a portion of a right-of-way easement.
