RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING
3 PROJECT AXIS FOR A BROWARD COUNTY STRATEGIC JOB CREATION
4 INCENTIVE PURSUANT TO SECTION 9½-52, BROWARD COUNTY CODE OF
5 ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A TOTAL APPROPRIATION OF THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND
6 SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$36,750) FOR A STRATEGIC JOB CREATION
7 INCENTIVE FOR FISCAL YEARS 2026 THROUGH 2031; AND PROVIDING FOR
8 SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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10 WHEREAS, the corporation referred to as Project Axis, for the purpose of this
11 Resolution, has requested that Broward County maintain the confidentiality of its name
12 and business information pursuant to Section 288.075, Florida Statutes;

13 WHEREAS, Project Axis, a Pennsylvania-based medical device sales &
14 distribution company, is considering locating a regional headquarters' in the City of Fort
15 Lauderdale, Florida; and

16 WHEREAS, Project Axis is requesting a Strategic Job Creation Incentive from
17 Broward County pursuant to Section 9½-52, Broward County Code of Ordinances, NOW,
18 THEREFORE,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
20 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

21 Section 1. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”)
22 hereby approves a Strategic Job Creation Incentive not to exceed a total amount of
23 Thirty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$36,750) for fiscal years 2026 through
24 2031, collectively, through Broward County’s Strategic Job Creation Incentive Program,
25 calculated on the basis of One Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$1,050) per qualifying job.

26 Section 2. In furtherance of Project Axis’s request for approval, the Board has
27 determined that the basis of this proposed project’s private sector wage commitment
28 calculation shall be greater than one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the average annual
29 private sector wage in Broward County.

30 Section 3. The amounts authorized herein shall constitute Broward County’s
31 total commitment to this project for participation in the Strategic Job Creation Incentive
32 Program.

33 Section 4. The County Administrator is authorized to execute all necessary
34 documents in connection with the award of the incentive, subject to review and approval
35 for legal sufficiency by the County Attorney’s Office, provided the County’s total financial
36 commitment does not exceed the maximum amount stated herein.

37 Section 5. The County Administrator is authorized to take all necessary
38 administrative and budgetary actions to implement and administer the incentive award.

39 Section 6. Severability.

40 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
41 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
42 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
43 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
