A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO WASTEWATER SERVICES; AMENDING SECTION 38.20 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE") TO PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF WASTEWATER LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County provides transmission, treatment, and disposal sewer services to large users of Broward County's North Regional Wastewater Treatment and Transmission Facility pursuant to certain large user agreements (the "Agreements");

WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an annual basis, and Broward County has completed its annual review accordingly;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be established following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the best interest of the public to revise Section 38.20 of the Broward County Administrative Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the North Regional Wastewater Treatment and Transmission Facility effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2025, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such intention.
