RESOLUTION NO.

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE HONORARY DESIGNATIONS OF THE "PHIL
3 SMITH MEMORIAL HIGHWAY," THE "TERRY STILES MEMORIAL BOULEVARD," AND
4 THE "RICK CASE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY," ON THE ROAD SEGMENTS AS SPECIFIED
5 IN FLORIDA SENATE BILL 628 (2026); RECOGNIZING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT
6 OF TRANSPORTATION AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HONORARY
7 DESIGNATION MARKERS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
8 EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, Florida Senate Bill 628 (2026), approved by Governor Ron DeSantis
12 on April 14, 2026, designates that portion of S.R. 5/U.S. 1 between N.E. 38th Street and
13 E. Commercial Boulevard as the "Phil Smith Memorial Highway," that portion of
14 S.R. 842/East Las Olas Boulevard between South Andrews Avenue and S.E. 6th Avenue
15 as the "Terry Stiles Memorial Boulevard," and that portion of S.R. A1A between the north
16 end of the Hillsboro Inlet and the next mile marker north of 991 Hillsboro Mile as the "Rick
17 Case Memorial Highway" (each a "Designated Segment" and collectively the "Designated
18 Segments") and directs the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to erect
19 suitable markers;

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 334.071(1), Florida Statutes, the honorary
21 designations do not require any action by Broward County or any private party to change
22 street signs, mailing addresses, or 911 emergency telephone number system listings;

23 WHEREAS, FDOT will be responsible for the placement and maintenance of the
24 honorary designation markers in each Designated Segment;

25 WHEREAS, Section 334.071(3), Florida Statutes, provides that the erection of
26 markers shall be contingent on the appropriate city or county commission passing a
27 resolution in support of the particular honorary designation; and

28 WHEREAS, the Designated Segments lie within Broward County, NOW,
29 THEREFORE,

30 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
31 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

32 Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are true and correct and are made
33 part of this Resolution.

34 Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
35 ("Commission"), hereby supports the honorary designation of that portion of S.R. 5/U.S. 1
36 between N.E. 38th Street and E. Commercial Boulevard as the "Phil Smith Memorial
37 Highway," that portion of S.R. 842/East Las Olas Boulevard between South Andrews
38 Avenue and S.E. 6th Avenue as the "Terry Stiles Memorial Boulevard," and that portion
39 of S.R. A1A between the north end of the Hillsboro Inlet and the next mile marker north
40 of 991 Hillsboro Mile as the "Rick Case Memorial Highway."

Section 3. The Commission recognizes FDOT as the agency responsible for erecting suitable markers for the honorary designations, including markers at the termini or intersections specified for each Designated Segment and such other markers as FDOT determines appropriate.

Section 4. Severability.

If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
