SUBJECT: No County Business Enterprise (CBE) Goal for Regional Effluent & Reuse Solutions Bid Package 2

Broward County's Public Works Department, via the Water & Wastewater Engineering Division, is seeking a qualified vendor to procure the construction of an effluent water transmission main and installation of other related items.

The project will be funded by the State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity with Federally Funded Community Development Block Grant, Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT), DEO Agreement No: MT042. In accordance with Section 255.0991, Florida Statutes, competitive solicitations for construction services that are paid for with any state-appropriated funds cannot have local jurisdiction-based requirements. Consequently, a CBE participation goal cannot be required for this contract. Prime Vendors are encouraged to consider utilizing CBE firms for subcontracting opportunities when feasible.

This contract is not subject to the Broward County Workforce Investment Program.

This contract is not subject to the Broward County Construction Apprenticeship Program.
