Contract JC025-15-2026

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into between the Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Council," and **Broward County, Florida**, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor," and collectively referred to as the "Parties," to amend Contract JC025-15-2026.

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the contract amount by \$333,333.10, increase the level of services accordingly, change the total contract funding from \$8,443,160.00 to \$8,776,493.10, and replace attachments.

(1) Section 4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**4. Contract Amount**

The Council agrees to pay for contracted services according to the terms and conditions of this Contract in an amount not to exceed **\$7,898,843.79** subject to the availability of funds. The Contractor will contribute **\$877,649.31** to the project in matching funds. Any costs or services paid for under any other contract or from any other source are not eligible for payment under this Contract.

(2) Exhibit 2 is hereby revised and replaced in its entirety.

(3) Attachment IV is hereby revised and replaced in its entirety.

All provisions in this amendment when executed will have an effective date of July 1, 2025. It will end at midnight, Eastern Standard time on June 30, 2026.

All provisions in the Contract and any attachments thereto in conflict with this amendment shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this amendment.

All provisions in the Contract not in conflict with this amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the level specified in the Contract.

This amendment and all of its attachments are hereby made a part of the contract.



(c) Any unexpended funds that remain at the end of the contract period must be returned to the Council.					
(d) Expenditures will be separately reported on the invoice.					
Because the funds may not be used for recurring future obligations, this means that Contractor cannot add new clients (unless for temporary services, such as APS cases) and cannot add ongoing services to an existing clients' Care Plan. Funds may be used for one-time purchases for existing clients, such as but not limited to one-time chore or enhanced chore and disaster preparedness kits for clients who do not already have one.
