1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF
3 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (“FDLE”) EDWARD BYRNE
4 MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,603
5 AND A BROWARD COUNTY MATCH CONTRIBUTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,480
6 FOR AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$463,083 TO SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS
7 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO
8 EXECUTE NEW AGREEMENTS WITH SPECIFIED SERVICE PROVIDERS AND TAKE
9 ALL NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT
10 THE AGREEMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE
11 DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (“FDLE”) has awarded
14 grant funding to Broward County (“County”) under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice
15 Assistance Grant program for the FDLE grant period of October 1, 2023, through
16 September 30, 2024 (“FY24”), to (i) purchase computer equipment and furniture for the
17 County’s Nancy J. Cotterman Center; (ii) purchase mental health first aid training books
18 to train first responders; (iii) provide sentence mitigation training for attorneys at the Law
19 Office of the Public Defender, 17th Judicial Circuit; and (iv) purchase computer
20 equipment, tablets, printers, and peripherals to provide human trafficking prevention and

21 educational program support for the State Attorney's Office, 17th Judicial Circuit;
22 (collectively, the "Services");

23 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
24 ("Board"), desires to appropriate and disburse funding for the provision of the Services;

25 WHEREAS, the Board further desires to authorize the County Administrator to
26 execute, on behalf of the County, new agreements with specified service providers; and

27 WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Services to be funded benefit the residents of
28 Broward County and serve a public purpose, NOW, THEREFORE,

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
30 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

31 Section 1. The Board hereby authorizes appropriation and disbursement of
32 FY24 FDLE grant funds in the amount of Four Hundred Thousand Six Hundred Three
33 Dollars (\$400,603) and a County match contribution of Sixty-two Thousand Four Hundred
34 Eighty Dollars (\$62,480) for an aggregate amount of Four Hundred Sixty-three Thousand
35 Eighty-three Dollars (\$463,083) as specified in Attachments A and B.

36 Section 2. The County Administrator is further authorized to execute new
37 agreements, in substantially the same form as the applicable Board-approved standard
38 form agreement, with the service providers identified in Attachment A and take all
39 necessary administrative and budgetary actions to implement the agreements. Nothing
40 in this Resolution alters the requirement that agreements be reviewed and approved for
41 legal sufficiency by the Office of the County Attorney before execution by the County
42 Administrator. Any material deviations from the applicable Board-approved form
43 agreement must be presented to the Board for approval.

44 Section 3. Severability.

45 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
46 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
47 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
48 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
49 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
50 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

51 Section 4. Effective Date.

52 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
