The Public Transportation Grant Agreement ("Agreement") between the Florida Department of Transportation ("Department") and Broward County ("Agency"), dated May 19, 2021, is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2025.

The Agency requests an Amendment of the Agreement, to extend the end date of the Agreement to: March 31, 2026, for additional time to complete the Project for the following reasons:

Broward County is requesting to extend contract number G1W45, which will expire on June 30, 2025. As it has been extensively documented previously, the COVID-19 pandemic adversely impacted access to construction materials and supplies, as well as related pricing. Consequently, Broward County has resumed projects post-pandemic. An extension of this contract would permit the County to install three (3) well-needed monument signs at the Miramar Park and Ride Facility and to complete the planned expansion of an existing bus bay/bus shelter location in support of our fixed-route I-95 Express Route Service. The anticipated completion of these projects is planned for March 31, 2026.

The Department agrees to the requested extension of the Agreement. All the terms and conditions of the Agreement and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
